- Greece, officially called the Hellenic Republic, is a country in southern Europe. It is located on the shores of the Aegean, Ionian and Mediterranean seas.

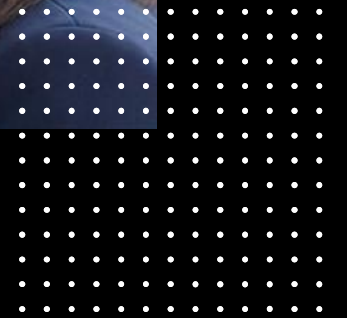
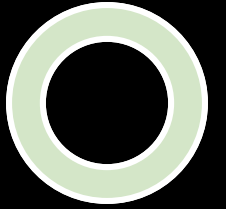
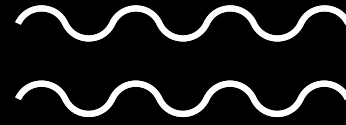

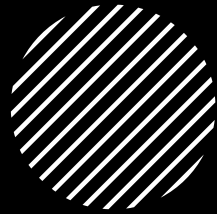
President of Greece
